She has worked with survivors of systemic injustices in Somalia, South Africa, Israel, Croatia, and Kosovo. Working with Physicians for Human Rights, she developed Bosnia's mass-grave exhumation and identification program. She is the founder of the Life After Exoneration Program, which helps exonerated prisoners in the United States with their transitions after release. She is a visiting scholar at the University of California, Berkeley's Institute of International Studies, co-editor of the Voice of Witness series, and a practicing clinician.

Dave Eggers is the editor of *McSweeney's* and the author of four books, including *What is the What* and *A Heartbreaking Work of Staggering Genius*, a finalist for the Pulitzer Prize and the winner of the Addison Metcalf Award from the American Academy of Arts and Sciences. As a journalist, his work has appeared in the *New Yorker*, the *New York Times*, *Esquire*, the *Guardian*, and other publications. His first book of oral histories, *Teachers Have It Easy: The Big Sacrifices and Small Salaries of America's Teachers*—co-edited and co-written with Daniel Moulthrop and Nínive Calegari, appeared in July of 2005.
